What?	 The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number and account transactions account balances and credit card or other debt credit history and checking account information 	
How?	All financial companies need to share members personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members personal information; the reasons Prestige Community Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Prestige CCU protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Prestige CCU collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you apply for credit or apply for membership open account
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	If any account owner requests to limit sharing, it will apply to all accour owners.
Definitions	
Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Prestige Community Credit Union has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Nonaffiliates we share with can include: CUNA Mutual, Experian, TransUnion, Equifax, Lanvera, Resource Financial, Inc., Auto Examand American Income Life.
Joint marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Joint Marketing company we share with can include: Vantiv
